The tutorial screens include the following interactive buttons:



Plays the movie. Click the Pause button () at the bottom of the movie window to pause the movie. Click the Frame Forward & Frame Back buttons () or use the scroll bar to advance and rewind the movie. Click outside the movie window to stop the movie.
